Membership categories and fees

Joint Adult / Family	£160	
Single Adult	£100	
Youth (Up to 18)	£20	
Off Peak and w/ends	£50	
Corporate	£50	
Coaching only member	£0	(not playing games of squash)

- *Off-peak membership entitles member to play weekdays at any time before 5:15pm and any time during the weekend.*
- *Corporate membership is provided to staff of companies where £150 is paid by the company to obtain the reduced cost benefit of £50 per person. Corporate members are entitled to play at any time and to play in matches for the club.*
- *For Joint Adult / Family membership both adults and children must live at the same address.*
- *A coaching only member is a person who only receives coaching fitness coaching by Neil Thompson. No courts can be booked or used at other times.*

Additional notes on membership fees

- *There is no discount for delayed renewal of the payment (even if a member has not made use of the courts). Exceptions to this might be made, but this would have to be considered and agreed to by the committee.*
- *These fees include affiliation with England Squash Racket Association and Wallingford Sports Park.*
- *The subscription year starts on 1st September. New members joining at other times through the year pay pro-rata on the basis of the number of whole months+1 till the following 1st September. There will be a minimum charge of £20 for any membership category for any reduced period.*
- *The door access code is usually re-set in October each year. Members who have paid their subscriptions will be informed at least one week before any changes are made to the door code.*

Visitors

A visitor to the club, who is a member of another squash club, who plays a member of this club can play a few times a year for a fee of £3 per visit (to be put into the letter box in the understairs door). Otherwise all players must be members with the exception of playing at Club Night and that is restricted to a maximum of 3 visits before joining as a member.

Casual / non-members players can book and use the courts. The Sports Park manager takes the bookings and charges £10 for an off-peak court and £13 for a peak time court.

Booking a Court

Members booking courts use the MyCourts booking website. There is a link to this from the club website.

Emails and contact by other club members

Please note that member communication by the club committee will be via email on matters relating to the squash club or Sports Park.

In choosing to join the club your name and email contact details will always be visible to all other members when they use the database for making court bookings. This is to facilitate arranging of games and was formally agreed at the 2019 AGM.

Box leagues

Box leagues are currently being run at the club. Any members who wish to join this will need to also allow their telephone numbers to be visible to other members. Please let a member of the committee know if you want to join in the boxes.

Door access code

The current door code is given to members on payment of their membership subscription.

The key box code for access and egress to the building (either side of the access door) is currently 5371. This is to ensure people can play when the bar is locked up. Bar opening times are currently flexible to minimise costs to the Sports Park.

Team squash

The club normally runs two teams in the Oxfordshire leagues. Please let us know if you are interested in playing Oxfordshire league squash.

Database and GDPR

Your personal details will be added to a club database (on the MyCourts website) which the Membership secretary and Chair of the committee and the organiser of the box league have access to for management purposes. Your details will be accessible to you and you can update your details at any time including the ability to set your privacy settings in compliance with GDPR requirements.

Your name and email address will also be able to be seen by other members in accordance with the AGM decision in 2019. These must not be deactivated in the GDPR settings. However contact details will not be displayed for Youth Members.

Safety and Policies

All of the club policies can be found on the website. It is your responsibility to ensure you have read them and comply with them.

The Covid Plan has been withdrawn. However please consider the welfare of the other members whether you have Covid or a cold.

The club policy related to safety and a risk assessment is posted on the club notice board.

Playing squash has inherent risks (getting hit by a racket or even a ball in the eye), so appropriate care must be taken at all times. In particular, those under 18 are strongly advised to wear safety glasses and preferably be accompanied by an adult. The use of safety glasses should not be considered to be limited to just young people.

In summary, behaviour on court is expected to be safe and courteous. Emotions and physical behaviour must be controlled and play must be conducted in a manner which considers health risks (over-exertion) and safety (avoid hitting your opponent with the racket or ball). Beginners, in particular, should take advice on court conduct from expert players to help minimise safety risks.

Equal opportunity

The club can be used by all in line with equal opportunities requirements. No discrimination is made on age, gender, disability or race. However it should be noted that there is no wheelchair access or lift to the viewing gallery and that the door into the club is narrow and may not allow a wheelchair to pass through it.

The youth policy expects a parent to be in attendance if a child is receiving coaching and children are strongly advised to wear safety glasses.

Dress code

There is only one rule associated with dress code and that is shoes used on court must be indoor sports shoes which are non-marking and are clean and never worn outside.

Parking/ Accessing the Courts

The club is based at Wallingford Sports Park which is on the outskirts of Wallingford by the Hithercroft Industrial Estate. There is a map on the 'contact us' page of the website. There is ample free parking at the Sports Park.
